<p>-CRP provides a ladder of job opportunities from detention alternatives to paid or supplemented work experience to placement unsubsidized employment.</p> <p>-CRP provides relationship-based case management that extends past job development to guidance resolving barriers related to food, drivers licenses, transportation, legal issues, health, domestic violence and/or substance abuse.</p> <p>-CRP provides services in a non-hierarchical and non-judgmental way.</p> <p>-Participants can cycle on and off the ladder depending on their needs.</p>	<p>-Participants are arriving at the worksites regularly</p> <p>-Participants are not defiant</p> <p>-Participants are not visibly under the influence of alcohol or other controlled substances while at work</p> <p>-Participants complete their work assignments</p> <p>-Participants develop work skills</p> <p>-Participants are taking care of themselves physically, receiving needed health care and eating.</p> <p>-Participants know their employment rights.</p> <p>-Participants work cooperatively with coworkers.</p> <p>-Participants are courteous and responsive towards their supervisors.</p> <p>-Participants know of and access workforce support services (including public aid and childcare).</p>	<p>-Participants are off parole or probation</p> <p>-Participants are not returning to jail or detention</p> <p>-Participants have held a paid job for 6 or more months</p> <p>-Participants are engaged in work and report feeling part of a team</p> <p>-Participants have transportation and are maintaining stable housing</p> <p>-Participants report having stronger support networks of peers and mentors</p> <p>-Participants report that family relationships are healing</p> <p>-Participants are accessing workforce support services when needed.</p>	<p>-Participants report holding meaningful jobs.</p> <p>-Participants report that their jobs provide an opportunity for advancement.</p> <p>-Participants are earning (at least) a living wage with health benefits.</p> <p>-Participants report being positively engaged in family and community activities.</p>
