Girls in same-sex relationships are at least 8x more likely to be arrested for statutory rape than their peers*




For every ten **boys** arrested with rape of a **girl** they don't have a relationship with,



there are eight **boys** in a relationship with a **girl** arrested for statutory rape,



forty-three **boys** in a relationship with a **boy** arrested for statutory rape,



and eighty **girls** in a relationship with a **girl** arrested for statutory rape.**

*Statutory rape incidents with white people identified as victims were more likely to end in arrest.

**The authors' analysis suggests this number could be as high as one hundred fifty-seven.
